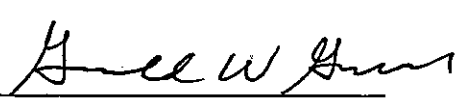

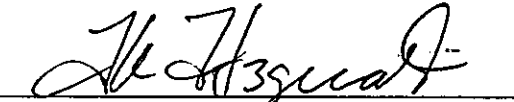
MATTERS TO BE PRESENTED BY STAFF
